- Summer and Winter Programme of Qualifying Competitions
- Area Qualifiers lead to Championships
- Area 2 Qualifiers managed by Hilary McKenna
- Championships managed by BRC
- Fee structure for Qualifiers – Area competition fee and BRC pre-entry fee
- Fee structure for Championships – competition and stabling fees
- Entry closing date for Qualifiers - always 21 days before competition date
- Some Area 2 competitions can be entered as Area only with no Pre entry fee
- Endurance Qualifying rides are in conjunction with Endurance GB and managed separately
